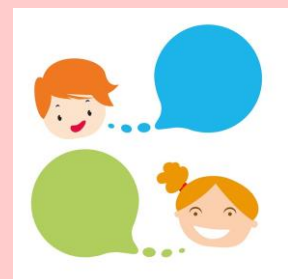
PRE-SCHOOL – NEW TOPIC
